### **Abstract:**

Among many functions of EA's National Committee on Coastal and Ocean Engineering (NCCOE) is the publication of guidelines to assist coastal engineers and planners. With the support of Department of Environment, Climate Change and Energy Efficiency the committee is currently updating *Coastal Engineering Guidelines for working with the Australian coast in an ecologically sustainable way*, the most recent edition of which dates from 2004. The presentation will detail the proposed changes and explain how it fits into a suite of guidelines including the soon-to-be-released Climate Change Guidelines and the yet-to-be-started *Climate Change Adaptation Guidelines*. The presentation will provide opportunity for input from the Coastal/Ocean engineering community.

### **The presenters:**

Tony Webb (PhD, MIEAust, CPEng) has over 35 years' experience as a coastal/environmental/hydraulics engineering practitioner and academic. From 1974 to 1988 he was an investigating engineer at Manly Hydraulics Laboratory. From 1989 to 2009 he was an academic with University of New South Wales at Australian Defence Force Academy where he retains a Visiting Fellow position. Study leave included extended periods at MIT, Stanford University and WRL. From 2009 he has been Director of Environmental Hydraulics Pty Ltd providing environmental engineering advice on a range of coastal and water issues. He has served as a member of NCCOE including a term as President.

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Doug Lord (BE, MEngSci, MBA, MIEAust, CPEng) has over 35 years' experience in coastal and estuarine engineering and management. From 1975 to 1987 he was a professional engineer with NSW Department of Public Works. From 1987 to 1994 he was director and principal of Geomarine Pty Ltd. From 1994 he has had 5 years as Senior Engineer and Associate of Willing and Partners, 5 years as Senior Engineering Consulting with Manly Hydraulics Laboratory and 11 years as manager Coastal with NSW Dept of Environment, Climate Change and Water. He is currently Director and Principal of Coastal Environment Pty Ltd, a position he also held while at MHL. He has also held a visiting lecturing position with University of Technology Sydney from 1996 to 2000. He is author or co-author of approximately 50 technical papers and has made several presentations to local and international conferences. He is a member NCCOE, including having served as President.
